Update on Friends of Kirtland Park

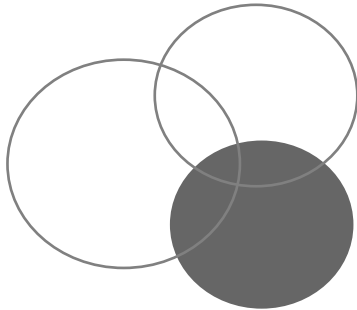
FKP Members worked with City Hall to provide better access to Kirtland Park.

There had been a "Do Not Enter" sign posted at East 49th Street and Hamilton a few years ago. We were concerned as it provided traffic access away from the park, but not to the park from the neighborhood as it barred traffic heading north.

After a number of calls and emails to different people and departments at city hall, the issue was resolved. **Commissioner of Traffic Engineering, Rob Mavec**, had the sign removed. **Assistant Director of Building and Housing, Ron O'Leary**, kindly met with us and explained the sign had been put up because of a dilapidated building at 4900 Lakeside, which the city had court ordered to repair or demolish. We wrote a letter to the owner, letting him know the property was an eyesore and disrupted our plans for the park.

The building is slated to be demolished. We are excited and hopeful that this property can be better used for the community.

Expansion Continues at OTC

Ohio Technical College, one of the finest technical colleges in the country, is expanding its campus. In an effort to create a campus-like atmosphere in heart of the St. Clair Superior community, OTC has bought two problem bars, acquired vacant property and given existing buildings a face lift. The North Coast Grill

and Marbles Bar were at one time two of the most problem bars in our area. Through OTC's expansion, they were able to buy these buildings and turn once blighted structures into class room space. A picture of the newly renovated Dillon Building at the Southwest corner of 49th street and St. Clair Avenue is below. In addition to Marbles Bar and the Dillon Building, OTC is also retrofitting the former City Desk building into classrooms as well. Through a partnership with Lincoln Electric, OTC has also opened a welding school on the corner of East 51st Place and St. Clair Avenue. This expansion is occurring at a much needed time as Ohio Technical College's enrollment is at an all-time high.

Shoreway Commerce Park

Shoreway Commerce Park, formerly the White Motors campus, has undergone a major transformation over the last three years. The developer, First Interstate Properties, has re-faced and revitalized nearly 450,000 sf of industrial space, which was former manufacturing space for the White Motor Company. This space has been re-furbished in a manner up to today's industrial standards, which will help to attract cutting edge industrial businesses to our neighborhood. In addition to the 450,000 sf of existing industrial space, Shoreway Commerce Park has cleared and remediated two shovel ready parcels. One parcel consists of 13.58 acres with rail access and another parcel is 3.28 acres fronting on St. Clair Avenue. In an effort to increase access to the facilities, Detour Avenue has been extended into the site from East 72nd to East 79th Street, thus allowing for rapid highway access off of East 72nd Street and this will also keep truck traffic off of St. Clair Avenue.

Alcoa-Tempcraft: Job Openings

St. Clair Superior Development Corporation and Alcoa-Tempcraft have teamed up again to connect neighborhood residents with job openings. St. Clair Superior Development Corp. will handle applications in Wards 3, 7 & 8. Over the past year Alcoa-Tempcraft has been hiring entry level manufacturing positions in an effort to fill 90 open positions. In March 2011 SCSDC took in nearly 200 applications from the neighborhood and surrounding areas. Alcoa was able to hire 10 people who lived in the SCSDC service area.

Because of the success of our last screening process, SCSDC will again be taking applications for Alcoa from September 13th to September 15th from 9:30AM to 4:00 PM. In order to receive an application, you **must provide a current form of identification (Drivers License, State ID, etc.) and proof of educational attainment, which would be a GED certificate or High School Diploma.** Applicants will not be given an application without ID and proof of educational attainment. Residents of Ward 3, 7, and 8 are welcome to fill out an application at St. Clair Superior offices. People who reside outside of Ward 3, 7, and 8 may obtain an application at Employment Connection, 1020 Bolivar Avenue (216-664-4673).

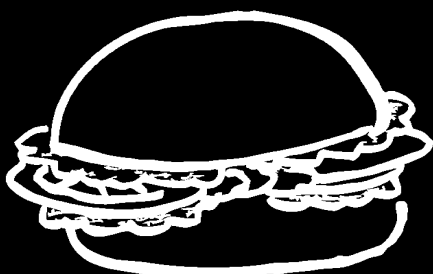

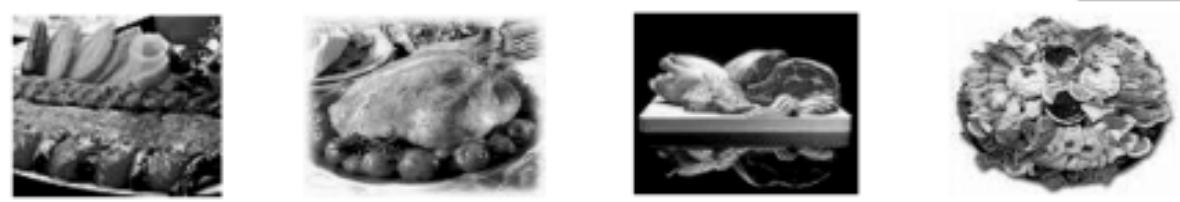

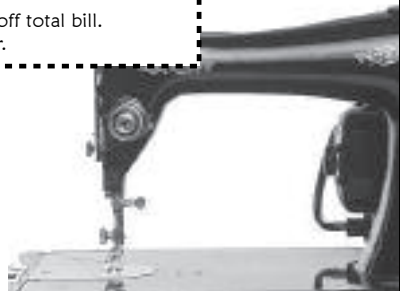
